CWW Rules and Charges

Switching

Intra-line Switching

- Intra-line switching is a movement of a rail car, loaded or empty, from one part of CWW to another. This includes, but is not limited to moves from track to another track, from one station to another, or between two points in the same track or station.

Switching Charges	Charge (per car)
Empty Car	\$300
Loaded Car – Non-hazardous	\$400
Loaded Car – Hazardous	\$500

Demurrage, Claims & Payment Terms

Demurrage – Railroad-marked equipment held for loading/unloading

- Any rail carrier-marked cars held for loading or unloading will be subject to a demurrage charge as outlined in the table below.
- Customers will have **one** free day for **loading** and **two** free days for **unloading**.
- No free weekends or holidays
- First free day is the day following placement

Daily Charges for RR Equipment	Daily Fee
Daily demurrage	\$130/day

Demurrage – Constructive placement

- When car, Railroad or Privately Owned, is available for loading or unloading but cannot be spotted for any reason outside the Railroad's control, such as limited space at customer's track or bunching; cars will be held on Railroad's track and be Placed Constructively (PCON).

Constructive Placement Charges	Daily Fee (no free time)
Daily demurrage	\$130/day
PCON Switch	\$250/car

Claims

- CWW will not be responsible for claims beyond those directly caused by acts/omissions of CWW. Any claims assessed against CWW from connecting carriers will be billed to customer located on CWW.
 - Cars returned to Railroad from connecting carriers due to inadequate or improper billing will be charged to customer located on CWW \$200 each occurrence.

Payment Terms

- All charges for service covered herein are due and payable within thirty (30) calendar days following presentation of the invoice. Payments received after expiration of the credit period shall be subject to a service charge of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month or fraction thereof, of the outstanding balance.
- Railroad reserves to right to cancel the credit and service of any customer for non-payment of an invoice.
